

2020-21 and Beyond Brand Competition

Deadline: **DECEMBER 31, 2018**

The Placitas Artists Series (PAS) sponsors a competition for our annual brand for PAS leading up to the season, during the season until the season ends, including on our website and the covers of our ticket brochure and program book.

The winning artist(s) receives a \$150 honorarium and a one-month exhibit selected by the winning artist from the PAS season, which runs September – May, 2020-21 being our 34th season.

Submission Requirements

- The artist must be a New Mexico resident.
- The artwork must evoke Placitas in some relatable way and be submitted in .jpg format.
- Images of any type of artwork, e.g. jewelry, sculpture, mixed media, painting, ceramics, fabric, etc., which can be captured in a compelling way, will be considered.
- A statement about how the artwork evokes Placitas and the inspiration or process which led to its creation must also be submitted.
- Email image and statements to vicki.gottlieb@gmail.com by **December 31, 2018**.
- The winning artist must agree in writing that PAS reserves the right to manipulate the image of the artwork, e.g. cropping and type overlaying part of the image, as needed, to meet different shapes, sizes and needs of PAS media. PAS will make every effort to work with the winning artist whenever cropping decisions are made. The winning artwork may have to be re-photographed, if a high-res photograph is unavailable or unsuitable.

Selection Process

All submitted images will be reviewed by a committee, which will make recommendations to the full board, which makes the final selection.

Winning Image Guidelines

The winning image may not be incorporated in its entirety and may not reflect the way the original artwork is usually viewed, e.g. placement, partial detail, repetition, other graphic devices, complementary color bands, etc.

PAS provides copyright protection language and will not use or duplicate the winning artwork for any purpose, except promotion or publicity.
